## MOVE UP Deadline is Monday, October 14, 2024 at 5:00PM

As per Chapter 1, Section 20, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the Owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order or otherwise at the secretary's or Judges discretion.

**EMAILED MOVEUPS:** When emailing a move up to us please give the following information: TRIAL NAME, Owner Name, Dog Call Name, Move up for what days (Saturday, Sunday, etc.), Moving from, Moving to (PLEASE include STD or JWW).

**NOVICE MOVEUPS: Dogs or Handlers having attained ANY AKC Agility Title must be moved to the Nov B Classes.** PLEASE NOTIFY US IMMEDIATELY OF THIS CHANGE. This request must be made in writing at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial. This request must state the reason and justification for the change from Novice A to Novice B. The dog can also be moved up a level (Nov to Open) at the request of the owner subject to the normal move-up criteria. **Day to day move-ups are accepted up to ½ hour after completion of the last run.**

Before the trial move-ups may be made prior to the move-up deadline via email to the trial secretary [k9trialssecretary@gmail.com](mailto:k9trialssecretary@gmail.com). Verbal move-ups will not be accepted. We **always** send a reply email with a revised confirmation attached to all emailed move-up requests once they are processed.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$15.00 for each additional entry per same dog per day; (Includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee per run)  
Envelopes/transactions cannot have entries for more than ten(10) dogs maximum.

**Trial is LIMITED to 350 runs per Judge per Day.**

**OPENING DATE** for entries is **Thursday, August 1, 2024 @ 8:00 AM EST**

**CLOSING DATE** for entries is **Friday, October 4, 2024 @ 8:00 AM EST** after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, substituted or changed except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

**Cancellation of entries before closing:** Entries cancelled before closing will not be charged a processing fee. No checks will be returned. Entry and check will be shredded.

**Refunds:** There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date (except for the reasons listed below). No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event organizing committee. No entry will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified or excused from competition by the action of the Trial Committee regardless of the reason for such dismissal. There is a \$5.00 processing fee for ALL refunds. **No refunds for overpayments of \$15 or less.**

**Bitches in season:** Bitches in season are not eligible to participate in agility trials.

Refund less AKC fees will be given. Notification must be given one (1) hour prior to start of trial to the Trial Secretary. Bitches in season are NOT allowed at the trial site.

**Returned Checks:** Do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$30 fee will be charged for bounced checks. Additional fees will apply for checks returned due to exhibitor negligence (ie: stop payment, insufficient funds, closed account)

**Telephone, Fax and Unsigned** entries cannot be accepted

**Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry forms without the Agreement and Rules** on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry form are NOT acceptable. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

**Errors on Entry** blank are the responsibility of the owner. No entry will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

**Judges are NOT required to wait for dogs.** The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility for providing service to locate dogs. **If you are not present, you will be marked absent.**

**Dogs Present** must always be on leash except when in the warm-up area or in the ring. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. An exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave.

**Trial Committee** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

**Dogs Participating** must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, ILP, PAL, or be FSS breeds eligible to compete. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

**Clean up** all exhibitors must clean up after their dogs. Please be respectful of the facility and do not allow your dog to urinate on manmade obstacles including trash cans, ring gating, etc. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**Food:** There will be food service available at the site.

**Obstacles** will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility.

**Equipment** The equipment for this event is being provided by NorAust, LLC

**Online Entries** This trial is accepting online entries through **LabTestedOnline.com**. Go to <http://www.labtestedonline.com> to create a user account and add your dogs.

Then look for the trial on your My Local Events page or search by state for (state). Click on the "i" information icon to the right of the club's name to create your entry.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 150 runs online, 200 runs paper each day/judge.

If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

**Waitlist** If a waitlist is needed, it will be held until move-ups have closed. Only entry fees replaced with someone from the waitlist will be refunded.

**Walkthroughs** will be determined after closing and included in your final confirmation.

## **Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

### **How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?**

**If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date:** One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

**If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date:** A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent Jump Height Card**" box on all future entry forms.

**Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement:** If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent Jump Height Card**" box on all future entry forms.

### **What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?**

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

### **May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?**

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

### **What is the jump height card challenge process?**

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

**It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day***

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

### **Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) FEO runs WILL be allowed at these trials.**

As of January 1, 2021, For Exhibition Only (FEO) and Fix and Go On (FNG) are permanent parts of the AKC agility program. Below is the updated language.

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

### **Fix and Go On (FNG)**

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

**Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.**

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials only**. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program<sup>SM</sup>** be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
